over Ten Mile Creek Bridge

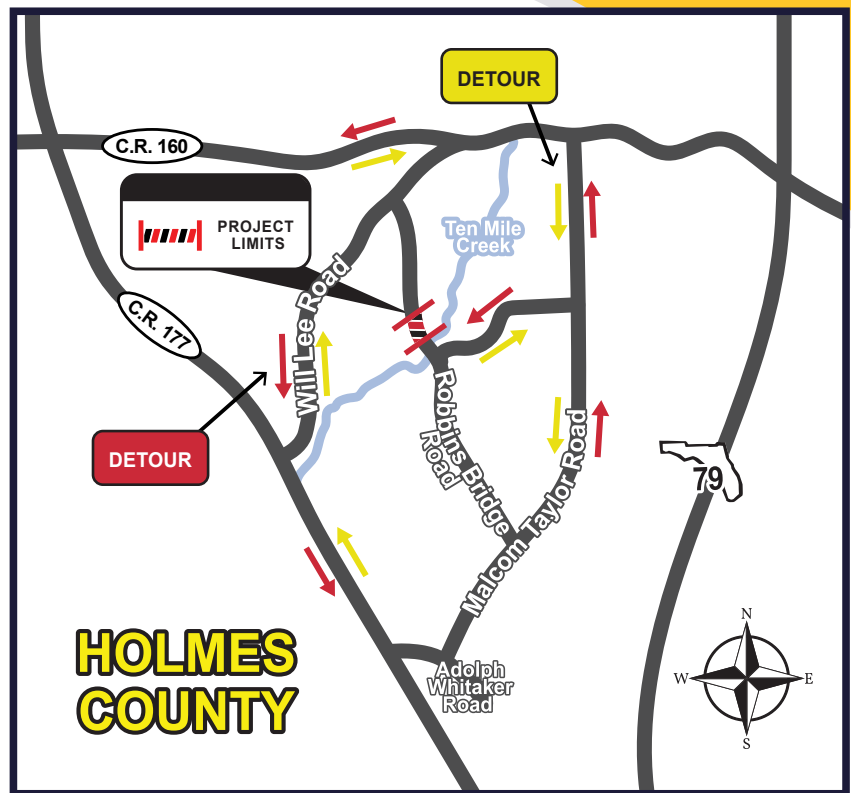


Project Description:

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will replace the wooden bridge on Robbins Bridge Road over Ten Mile Creek with a concrete structure. The bridge replacement project will include widening the roadway to accommodate 10-foot lanes and two-foot shoulders, paving the approaches, placement of new signs and pavement markings, and minor drainage upgrades. Additional right-of-way will be required for the construction of the concrete bridge.

Traffic Impact:

Robbins Bridge Road will be temporarily closed at the bridge and traffic detoured for about six months. See map for detour.
